The Romans Road (BSB)

- <u>Romans 3:23-24</u> For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus.
- <u>Romans 6:23</u> For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- <u>Romans 5:8</u> But God proves His love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
- Romans 10:9-10 That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with your heart you believe and are justified, and with your mouth you confess and are saved.
- Romans 10:13 For, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."
- <u>Romans 5:1</u> Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,
- <u>Romans 8:1</u> Therefore, **there is now no condemnation** for those who are in Christ Jesus.

<u>Romans 8:38-39</u> For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor principalities, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, **nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord**.

- Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ, and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.
- <u>Romans 6:6</u> We know that **our old self was crucified with Him so that the body of sin might be** rendered powerless, that we should no longer be slaves to sin.
- <u>Romans 8:10</u> But if Christ is in you, your body is dead because of sin, yet your spirit is alive because of righteousness.
- <u>1 Corinthians 6:20</u> You were bought at a price. Therefore glorify God with your body.
- <u>Colossians 1:13-14</u> He has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of His beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.
- <u>Ephesians 2:8-9</u> For it is by grace you have been saved through faith, and this not from yourselves; it is the gift of God, not by works, so that no one can boast.
- <u>Colossians 1:27</u> To them God has chosen to make known among the Gentiles the glorious riches of this mystery, which is **Christ in you, the hope of glory**.
