

Comparison of Trumpets in Revelation 8 and 16 and corresponding plagues in Exodus¹

1st trumpet: Hail, fire, mixed with blood, vegetation burned (Rev 8:7), 1/3 of trees & all grass burned		7th plague: Thunderstorm of hail and fire (Ex 9:13-35)
2nd trumpet: Mtn thrown into sea, 1/3 of sea turned to blood (Rev 8:8-9), 1/3 of sea life died	2nd bowl: Sea became blood (Rev 16:3), everything in it died; 3rd bowl: Rivers & springs turned to blood (Rev 16:4-7)	1st plague: Water into blood (Ex 7:14-24), fish died
3rd trumpet: Star fell, turned 1/3 waters bitter (Rev 8:10-11), many died		10th plague: Death of firstborn? (Ex 11:1-12:36)
4th trumpet: Darkness (Rev 8:12)	5th bowl: beast's kingdom darkened, pain, and sores (Rev 16:10-11)	9th plague: Darkness (Ex 10:21-29)
5th trumpet: Demonic "Locusts", people tormented by stings (Rev 9:1-11)		8th plague: Locusts (Ex 10:1-20); 6th plague: Boils (Ex 9:8-12)
6th trumpet? 1/3 of mankind killed by plagues of fire, smoke, brimstone (Rev 9:18)		10th plague: Death of firstborn? (Ex 11:1-12:36)
7th trumpet: Worship and beginning of (final) judgment (Rev 11:15-19), also great hailstorm (Rev 11:19 ; see also Rev 16:21)		7th plague: Thunderstorm of hail and fire (Ex 9:13-35)
	1st bowl: malignant sores (Rev 16:2);	6th plague: Boils (Ex 9:8-12)
