



Setting up CodeHS for Python course

1. Go to <https://codehs.com> and click on “Sign Up For Free”.



2. Click on “At Home Learner” in bottom right corner. (Do NOT click on “Student”.)



3. It should take you to this page. Of course, you want the Free option, so click on that. It should turn blue and change what's at the bottom of the form.

4. When “Free” turns blue, scroll to the bottom of the form.




5. Fill in the blanks to create an account. Then click on “Create Account”.

6. When done, it should take you to this screen. Click on “Python”.




7. Click on “Read Full Textbook”
